Can I print any mainframe screen with no charge?

Yes. Any aoc mainframe screen you view can be printed without any additional charge.

Will the printout be just like a courthouse computer printout?

Yes. The screen printouts will be the same as the courthouse computer screen printouts.

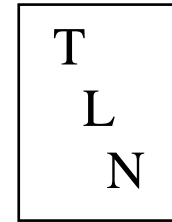
Will your invoice show what screens I viewed?

The NC AOC provides us with this information based on your user id. The NC AOC only provides the number of screens viewed each day.

A screen, according to the NC AOC, is anytime information changes on the mainframe view. To view different screens, in most cases, you use a function key. Even if you clear a screen and receive a blank screen, it would be a different screen.
